and recurrent weeds, growing or likely to be growing, and refuse, situated or

likely to be situated, on those properties identified in the Report are a public

nuisance; and

C. The Council hereby directs the County of Santa Clara's Consumer and

Environmental Protection Agency - Weed Abatement Program, to mail a Notice

of Public Hearing to occur on February 10, 2026, at 1:30 p.m. before the City

Council to property owners of affected real properties on the Report pursuant to

Chapter 9.12 of Title 9 of the San José Municipal Code and the Weed Abatement

Agreement between the City of San José and the County of Santa Clara.
