WHEREAS, on September 16, 2025, the City Council approved the purchase of a new fixed-wing aircraft for the San José Police Department, and identified the major sources required to fund the purchase which included the anticipation of utilizing either donors or future Supplemental Law Enforcement Services grant allocations to obtain additional equipment for the aircraft; and

WHEREAS, the San José Police Foundation desires to donate an L3 Harris MX15 Camera Imaging System and associated equipment, such as software, antenna, controller, and workstations, which will enable the aircraft to observe critical information from altitudes of 4,000 to 5,000 feet, providing an increased level of situational awareness to the officers on the ground, resulting in an increased margin of safety for the officers and the general public, while also allowing for a more efficient use of resources; and
