RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Dumpster Days will be held on March 28, June 13, August 8, and September 26, 2026, at various District 9 neighborhoods and sponsored by Vice Mayor Pam Foley. These special events allow residents to drop off their household items for disposal. The events are free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Vice Mayor Pam Foley will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the
