I, Patrick Brodehl, declare:

1. I have personal knowledge of the facts contained in this document, and if called to testify, I could and would do so competently.

Background

I am an unhoused resident of San José where I have lived for some time, and I rely on salvaging, recycling, and repairing items to survive, support myself, and provide for basic needs. The property I keep with me is essential for my survival and livelihood.

I have worked my entire adult life in construction. I am a journeyman contractor with Local 713 in Alameda County, where I have proudly been a member for nine years and remain active today. My work has included building apartment complexes in Oakland and San Francisco, and I have always taken pride in helping create housing for others. Coming from Arizona originally, with my father living in Stockton and my brother who is also a contractor settling in River Pines in 2016, I built my life and career in the Bay Area surrounded by family and steady work.

For years, I believed I would never become homeless. I built homes for others, worked hard, and lived responsibly. But after my job situation changed and steady work dried up, I faced difficult choices. To try to start fresh, I turned in my annuity, received \$5,000, and used that to purchase an RV trailer so I could have a place to live while I sought stability and began a new chapter.

I came to San José with the hope of building a new life for myself, with my skills, my family's support, and my union background giving me the strength to begin again. What has followed instead are repeated losses of the few belongings and tools I depend on, making it nearly impossible to get back on my feet.

Location

At the time of this incident, my property was located between a tree and a trailer near the intersection of Emory St. and Chestnut St. (see the attached location for where I was located, marked by the "x" in red on the photograph). I carefully arranged my belongings there and relied on the stability of this location for my daily living.

Notice From and Communication With City or Agency Prior to Enforcement Action

Prior to this enforcement, the only information I ever saw was a general "Beautify" flyer about neighborhood guidelines. That flyer contained no specific dates, times, or locations for any abatement. I was never provided with formal notice or given any real chance to protect my belongings.

On the day of the enforcement, City staff arrived and told me I had twenty minutes to take everything I wanted, and that whatever I could not carry immediately would be towed and taken. This was not meaningful notice. It was impossible to move the amount of belongings I had in such a short period, and I was not given any written documentation or instructions about how to retrieve my property afterward.

A friend of mine was helping me load my things, but a police officer told him to stop immediately,

further limiting my ability to salvage even the most essential items.

Day of Enforcement Action

When the City arrived when the incident happened around August 11, 2025, I had a well-established space that included a six-foot-tall storage container, a metal box structure around it, and multiple containers placed neatly to the side and inside. I also had a cart with sodas valued between \$300 and \$400, which I used not only for myself but to share with others in the community.

Despite the organization and value of my setup, the City seized or destroyed the items without providing any paperwork, receipts, or explanation.

Description of Property Seized (see attachment for itemized list)

Among the items taken during the enforcement were:

- Two floor jacks (3-ton each) one was borrowed and I owed \$80 for it.
- 12-inch chop saw.
- Levels.
- Shovels three rounded, one flat, and one sharpshooter shovel.
- 8–10 planters with radishes, cabbage, hibiscus, tomatoes, elephant ears, and lavender.
- Work vest with integrated tools (valued \$300–\$400), including a magnet with bits, pry bar, screwdrivers, pliers, speed square, tape measure, 90-degree driver, and more.
- Shoes two pairs of Nike, a couple of Adidas, and two pairs of Red Wing boots (approx. \$300 each).
- 3-4 bags of clothing.
- **Electronics** two JBL speakers (one round, one square).
- Upholstery and sewing equipment including a handheld sewing machine, Dewalt stapler, leather materials, waterproof military fabric, and supplies I was preparing for the Fall Festival.
- Groceries and food stock multiple rows of tuna, nuts, cranberries, juices, Uncle Ben's rice, oatmeal, soups, beef jerky, and sodas, all carefully organized to resemble a grocery store. This food was important not just for me but for others in the community.

Harm Caused From City's Actions

The City's actions caused far more than financial loss. They stripped me of the tools and

equipment I rely on as a general contractor to earn income and maintain stability. They took clothing, shoes, and electronics that are basic necessities for daily life.

Even more damaging was the loss of plants and personal items tied to my girlfriend's recovery journey. The lavender plant represented hope, healing, and stability, and it was deeply painful for both of us to see it taken after so much care.

The City's seizure also destroyed the small system I had built to support not only myself but also the surrounding unhoused community. I had organized my food supplies in a way that brought dignity and cheer to people who stopped by. Neighbors would often share meals, and something as simple as offering a soda and a bag of chips would lift spirits and restore a sense of humanity. People are hurting and all of a sudden it brings cheer to them. You would be shocked at how a soda and a bag of chips changes someone's day entirely when they're homeless. Losing this setup harmed not only me but also others who relied on it for encouragement, connection, and sustenance.

Finally, the constant forced movement, coupled with being told by police to relocate from one area (Taylor and Coleman) only to have my belongings seized at another, has made it impossible for me to plan or rebuild stability. As a contractor trying to continue working and contributing, these repeated disruptions leave me unable to maintain the basic foundation I need for my livelihood and dignity.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California and the United States

But when your life is constantly uprooted, when you are told to move every few days and have so little that is stable or safe, the ability to carry and care for something living becomes profoundly important. That lavender was not just a decoration; it something irreplaceable. For my girlfriend, it felt like being told that even her small victories and symbols of recovery were not allowed to exist. And for me, it was heartbreaking to watch something we had nurtured together, that had finally bloomed, be discarded without care or recognition of what it meant. e.

- The City also took my carefully built grocery stock, rows of canned tuna, soups, oatmeal, nuts, cranberries, juices, sodas, precooked rice, beef jerky, and more, that I had spent time and energy collecting, organizing, and displaying. To someone who has never lived without stable housing, it may look like just piles of food. But for me, it was a source of dignity, pride, and community.
