SUBJECT: Report on the Request for Proposal for the Fire Department's

Background Investigations Consultant Services

RECOMMENDATION

- (a) Accept the report on the Request for Proposal for the Fire Department's Background Investigations Consultant Services.
- (b) Adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager, or her designee, to:
 - (1) Negotiate and execute an agreement with DR Associates International to provide background investigations for an initial five-year term beginning February 10, 2026, through February 9, 2031, for a maximum compensation not-to-exceed \$630,000 for the initial term, subject to the appropriation of funds;
 - (2) Negotiate and execute amendments as required to add, delete, or modify services to address seasonal variations, budgetary constraints, or unanticipated changes in demand, subject to the appropriation of funds; and
 - (3) Exercise up to five one-year options to extend the term of the agreement through January 1, 2036, subject to the appropriation of funds.

SUMMARY AND OUTCOME

Approval of this recommendation will provide the continuity of the required background investigations consultant services for the Fire Department (Department). This critical service is a component of the hiring process and ensures candidates are trustworthy, reliable, and qualified to serve in a public safety role. Background investigations verify a

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candidate's personal, professional, and criminal history to assess their suitability and to ensure those who are selected to move forward in the hiring process are competent to uphold public trust and handle high-pressure situations.

BACKGROUND

The Department's Bureau of Administrative Services – Human Resources and Internal Affairs Unit is responsible for the management of consultant services necessary to conduct pre-employment background investigations for public safety positions. In coordination with the Department, the consultant services assist in developing background investigation processes, completing administrative tasks, candidate orientations, hosting personal interviews, completing background investigations, and providing reports.

The last Request for Proposal (RFP) for Background Investigations consultant services was conducted in 2020. DR Associates International was awarded a three-year contract with two one-year options to extend.

In October 2025, the City issued an RFP for Background Investigations consultant services for the Department, the results of which are detailed in the analysis section below.

ANALYSIS

On October 2, 2025, the City released a new RFP for Background Investigations consultant services through the City's e-procurement system (Biddingo). The RFP was downloaded by 21 unique companies, and ultimately, the City received seven proposals. The RFP closed on October 24, 2025.

Evaluation Process

The proposals were evaluated and scored independently by a three-member evaluation team consisting of Department subject-matter experts. Oral interviews were determined to be unnecessary based upon scoring review and time and cost considerations. The evaluation scores are summarized in Table 1 below:

Protest

The RFP process included a ten-day protest period that commenced when the City issued the Notice of Intended Award on November 14, 2025. No protests were received.

Award Recommendation

The evaluation panel used the criteria established within the RFP. Upon conclusion of the review process, the panel recommended to award DR Associates International.

EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

No additional follow-up needs to be provided on this item, and no additional evaluation will be conducted.
