Dear Mayor Mahan and Members of the San José City Council,

Please approve Item 2.17: submit a request to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) for the allocation of Fiscal Year 2026- 2027 Transportation and Development Act, Article III (TDA3) state grant funding in the amount of \$1,870,510 for bicycle and pedestrian projects.

Please also remember that as part of the grant process, MTC requires the City Council to adopt a resolution making certain findings such as that "the City agrees to maintain, or provide for the maintenance of, the project(s) and facilities... for the benefit of and use by the public". Maintenance of these facilities is key to creating a walkable and bikeable city that furthers San Jose General Plan goals and policies as well as Vision Zero goals.
