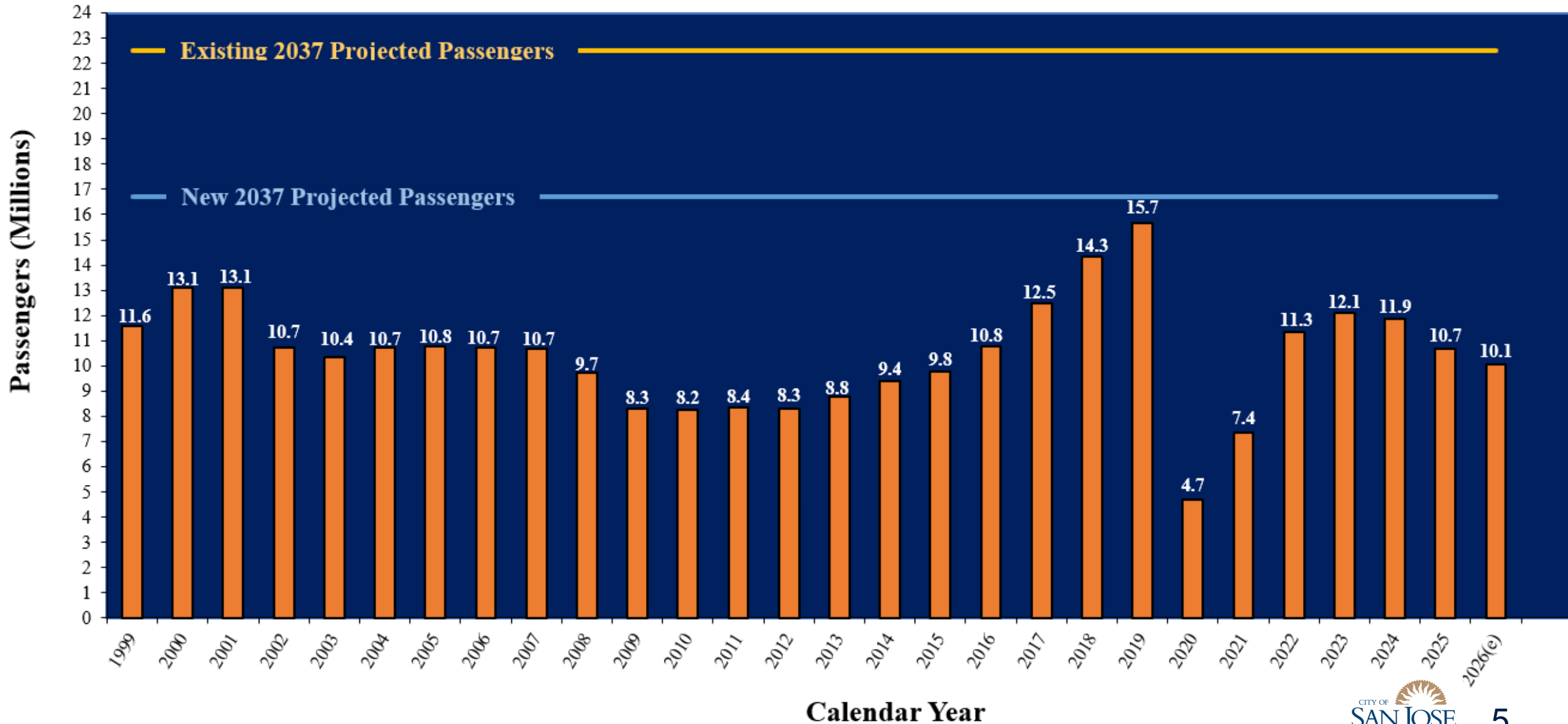
Airport Master Plan Overview

- Long range guide to Airport facility development
- Not a rigid schedule to begin specific projects, phased based on financial capacity
- City Council reviews all major Capital Improvement Projects
- Previous Major Master Plan Amendment in 2020

Master Plan Amendment - Purpose and Need

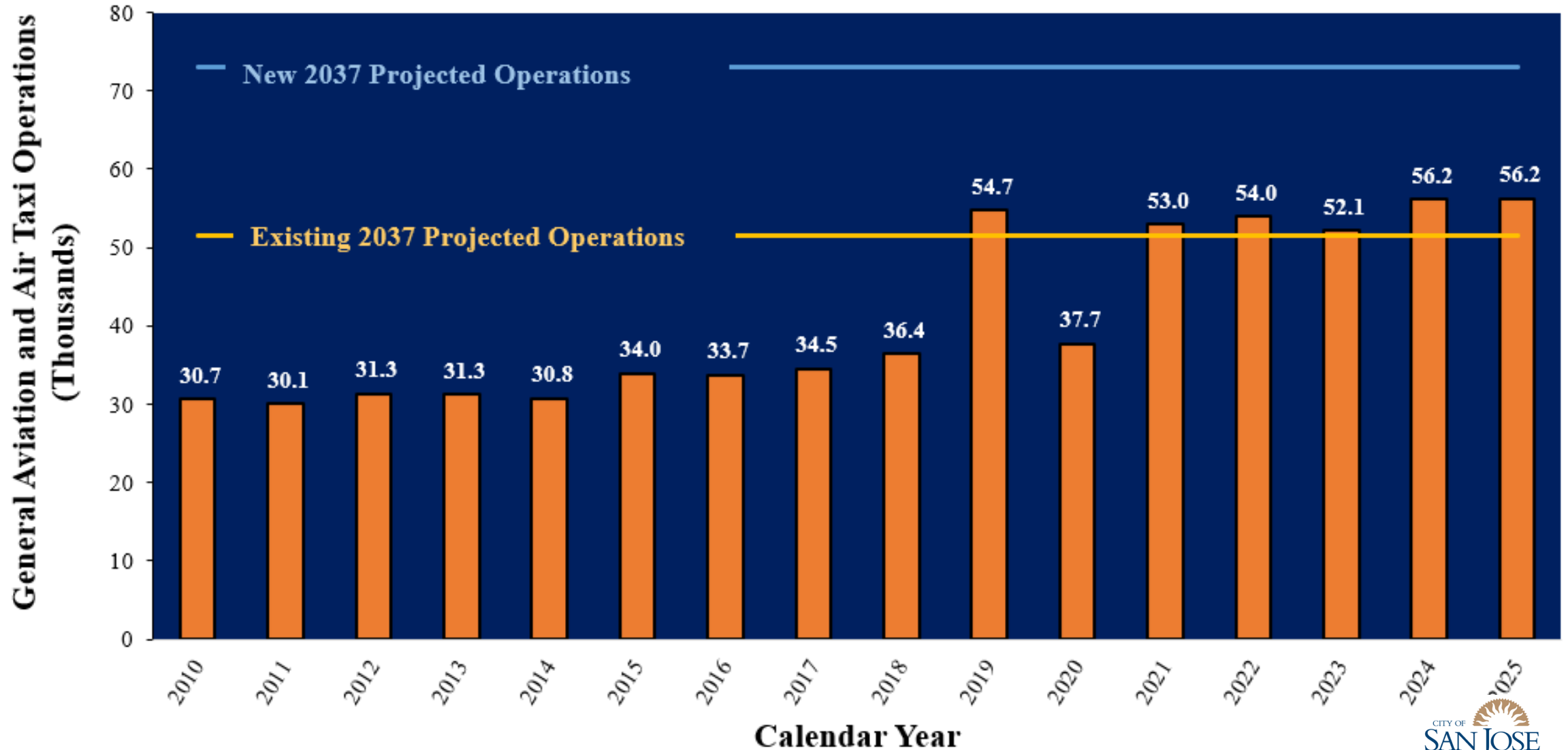
- Re-evaluate the Airport Master Plan against post-pandemic aviation activity levels
- Planning required for future economic development opportunities
- Respond to emerging electric vertical takeoff and landing industry developments and integrate into Master Plan

Environmental Review

Staff Recommendation
