RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Approve the Proclamation for the Holiday Children Book Drive on December 4, 2025 and the Holiday Children Book Drive from December 4-18, 2025 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event in collaboration with the Fire Department
- 3. Place the item on the December 2, 2025, Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Holiday Children Book Drive will start on December 4, 2025, at San José City Hall Lobby, sponsored by Councilmember Rosemary Kamei in collaboration with District 2, the Fire Department, and San Jose Public Library. Book barrels will be placed in the City Hall Lobby from December 4 to December 18. This special event celebrates the holidays, and its purpose is to collect books for children. The event is free and open to the public.
