A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE ACCEPTING THE 2025 INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN TASK FORCE INVITED AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$641,658, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY GRANT AGREEMENTS, AMENDMENTS, AND ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS, INCLUDING ONLINE CERTIFICATIONS AT TIME OF AWARD ACCEPTANCE AND REIMBURSEMENT REQUESTS, WITHOUT FURTHER CITY COUNCIL ACTION

WHEREAS, in 1998, the U.S. Department of Justice's Office of Juvenile Justice Delinquency and Prevention ("OJJDP") created the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force ("ICAC") Program in response to the increasing number of children and teenagers using the Internet, the rapid increase in numbers of child sexual abuse images available electronically, and intensified online activities by predators seeking unsupervised contact with children; and

WHEREAS, the City of San José Police Department ("Department") recognized the need to protect the children in the community in a fast-growing trend of Internet uses and various social media platforms, and in February 2003, the Department applied for and was awarded its first ICAC grant from the OJJDP; and

WHEREAS, since then, the Department has applied for and received several ICAC continuation grants, which have provided overtime, equipment, and vehicles for investigations; training of investigators; and opportunities for two national ICAC trainings in a year; and

WHEREAS, funding has also provided equipment and training for investigators from 11 Bay Area counties who participate in the Silicon Valley Internet Crimes Against Children

(“SVICAC”) Task Force as the Department serves as the Fiscal Agent for this regional award; and

WHEREAS, this award is a continuation of a three-year grant cycle: (i) in October 2023, the OJJDP invited the Department to apply for the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 grant and received an award of \$644,004; (ii) in December 2024, the Department applied and received a supplemental award of \$642,113, appropriated in Fiscal Year 2024-25; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to accept the 2025 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Invited Award in the amount of \$641,658, in addition to the grant funding of \$664,004 received in 2023-2024 and the supplemental award of \$642,113 received in Fiscal Year 2024-2025, for a total grant award of \$1,947,775, with a grant term of October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026, to provide critical funding to the Department for the SVICAC Task Force;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

- A. The 2025 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Invited Award in the amount of \$641,658 is hereby accepted.
- B. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to execute any Grant Agreements, amendments, and all related documents, including online certifications at time of award acceptance and reimbursement requests, without further City Council action.
