A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR THEIR DESIGNEE TO (A) AWARD AND EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR 10180 – SJC NEW TAXIWAY V PHASE 3A PROJECT TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE, RESPONSIBLE BIDDER, IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$15,215,000; (B) DECIDE ANY TIMELY BID PROTEST(S) AND MAKE THE CITY'S FINAL DETERMINATION AS TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER THAT IS RESPONSIBLE AS NEEDED TO AWARD THE CONTRACT; AND (C) APPROVE A CONTINGENCY OF UP TO 10% OF THE AMOUNT OF \$15,215,000 THE CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of San José (“City”) City Council desires to adopt this resolution for the reasons set forth in the memorandum, dated January 12, 2026, from the Director of the Department of Public Works, Matt Loesch, and the Director of Aviation, Mukesh (Mookie) Patel for the February 3, 2026, City Council meeting (“Memorandum”);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager or their designee is hereby authorized to:

- A. Award and execute a construction contract for 10180 – SJC New Taxiway V Phase 3A Project to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, in an amount not-to-exceed \$15,215,000;

- B. Decide any timely bid protest(s) and make the City's final determination as to the lowest responsive bidder that is responsible as needed to award the contract; and

C. Approve a contingency of up to 10% of the amount of \$15,215,000 the contract for the construction of the project.
