**WHEREAS**, due to increased access to computers and other technology-related communication devices, the potential for online victimization of children and youth, including unwanted exposure to sexual material, unwanted sexual solicitations, and online harassment, has increased; and

WHEREAS, the City of San José ("City") Police Department's Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force, known as the Silicon Valley Internet Crimes Against Children ("SVICAC") Task Force, conducts proactive and reactive investigations into computer and technology crimes perpetrated against children; and

**WHEREAS**, the SVICAC Task Force received its first federal grant award in 2003, followed by its initial California Governor's Office of Emergency Services ("Cal OES") grant award in 2007; and

WHEREAS, in August 2025, Cal OES released a grant solicitation for the Fiscal Year 2025 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Grant Program, and the Police Department desires to submit an application for a grant in the amount of \$1,350,000, for a term from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026, that will be used for personnel costs including two Digital Forensic Analyst positions, and operating costs
